This memo serves to inform all staff and members of the public that following sites at Blyde River Canyon Nature Reserve: Pinnacle, God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes and Three Rondawels will be temporarily closed following a positive testing for COVID-19 by a staff member.

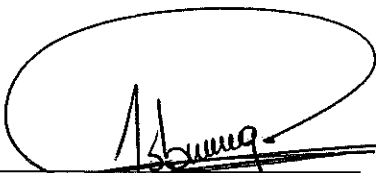
The facilities will be closed with immediate effect and operations will resume on Friday, 19 February 2021 at 07:30. During the closure of these facilities, decontamination and disinfection process will take place.

The officials who had direct contact with the affected employee will be contacted and advised to self-isolate for a period of 10 days, in order to monitor any COVID-19 symptoms. If any of the officials experience any symptoms, they should seek medical attention and inform the Health and Wellness Manager, Ms. Bathabile Mhlongo on 073 831 5604.
